
Fixing Guide INTRAD BHB-125



General Information

INTRAD materials should be stored flat and protected against damage. Allow 24 hours for materials to reach ambient room temperature.





STEP1

Mark out wall at required height.



STEP 2

Drill the aluminium at 600mm centres and use as a template to mark the wall for drilling.



STEP 3

Select the correct fixings for the wall construction and drill the wall accordingly



STEP 4

Fix the end caps to the aluminum core with self tapping screws. Fix from the back inwards.



STEP 5

Fix the bed head buffer to the wall. Ensure the location groves of the aluminum core and spacer block line up correctly




STEP 7

Clip in the impact absorber

STEP 6

Snap the high impact cover onto the aluminium.
